Margaret Wilkinson is a professional member of the Society of Analytical Psychology, London and an assistant editor of the Journal of Analytical Psychology. She teaches neuroscience research leading seminars for the Northern School of Child and Adolescent Psychotherapy at the University of Leeds and at The Society of Analytical Psychology, London, and has a particular interest in the adolescent 'mind brain'.

Margaret lectures internationally on contemporary neuroscience and its relevance to clinical practice and is the author of numerous papers. Her book 'Coming into Mind. The Mind-Brain Relationship: A Jungian Clinical Perspective' was published by Routledge in 2006. Her forthcoming book 'Changing Minds' is to be published by Norton in 2009. 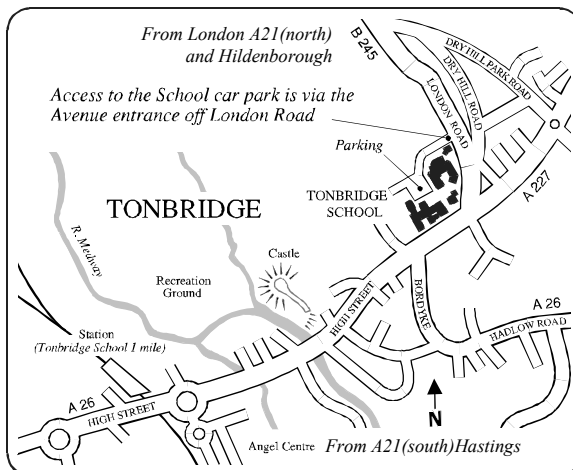
